| Real-world Impact | Practical applicability, scalability, how effectively it addresses a real need. | 20 |
| Demo / Working Product | Functionality of live demo, prototype completeness, reliability during presentation. | 20 |
| Presentation Clarity | Clarity of explanation, slide/pitch quality, confident Q&A handling. | 10 |

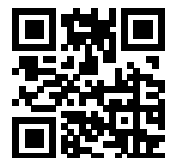
